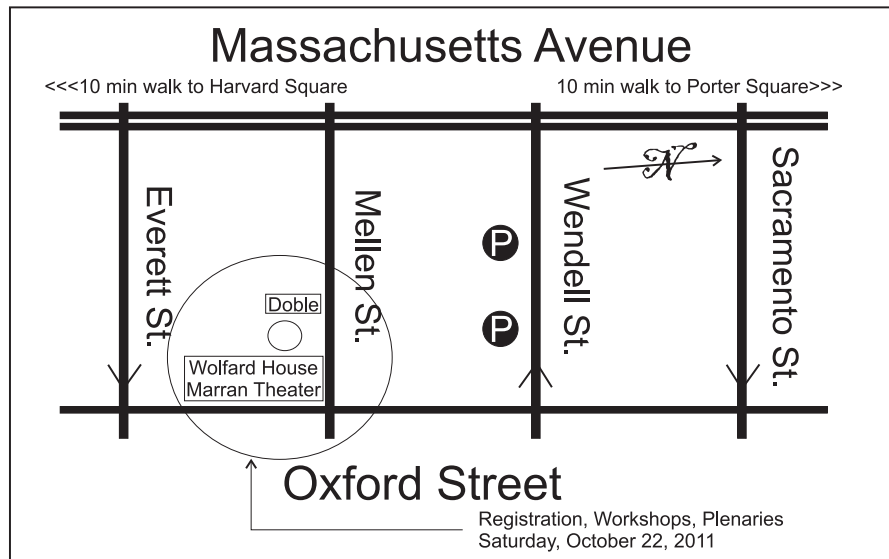
Lesley University – DMC 2011 Conference Locations
